## Working Wheels show their stuff at Centralia library this Saturday

Get a close look at some of the biggest and hardest-working vehicles in Lewis County. Drivers of everything from emergency vehicles to garbage trucks will bring their “wheels” to the [Centralia Timberland Library](#), answer questions and demonstrate their vehicles. Join library staff on Silver Street in front of the library on Saturday, September 25 from 2:30 to 5 p.m. to celebrate the big machines and the workers that keep our community clean and safe. The street will be closed to traffic.

The following organizations are bringing vehicles:

- Riverside Fire Authority (fire engine, ladder truck, ambulance)
- Centralia Police Department (police car)
- Centralia Public Works (uncertain, possibly a sewer camera van!)
- City Light (bucket truck, a.k.a. cherry picker)
- LeMay Inc. (garbage/sanitation truck)

Library staff have created an activity booklet with conversation starters (for talking to the drivers), fun facts, puzzles, coloring page, and a layout of the street. The main activity is the "Truck Expert Badge" in which children are encouraged to write down five things they learned or noticed about the vehicles. When they turn it in they get a paper Truck Expert Badge. Five of the badges will be instant winners of small prizes. The library will set up a canopy and there will be punch and cookies.
