Lacey library closes after 5 p.m. Saturday for final week of remodel

The [Lacey Timberland Library](#) will be closed after 5 p.m. Saturday, July 9 for the final week of its remodel. Doors will open to the public at 10 a.m. on Monday, July 18, one week sooner than originally expected.

Library books and other items that patrons had placed on hold will be unavailable during the closure, so Lacey librarians encourage people to pick up their holds before closing time at 5 p.m. this Saturday.

New holds that patrons place for pickup at the Lacey Timberland Library will not be available until after the 18th. People may wish to place time-sensitive materials on hold for pickup at an alternate location, such as the Olympia or Tumwater Timberland Library. Book drops will be open for people to return library materials.

The weekly Lacey library Summer Reading Program prizes will be distributed as scheduled outside the library.

Timberland Regional Library provides for the information, reading and lifelong learning needs of the Grays Harbor, Lewis, Mason, Pacific, and Thurston county public at 27 community public libraries and 7 library service partner locations.
