Mountain View Timberland Library to close June 1 through 14 for new paint, carpet

The Mountain View Timberland Library in Randle will be closed June 1 through 14 for painting and installation of new carpet. During the closure, library materials will be mailed to patrons and due dates will be extended until the library reopens.

For library services during the closure

Materials on hold: While the library is closed, materials that library cardholders had placed on hold will be mailed to them as they become available.

Returning materials and due dates: People may return books and other library materials to the book drop at the Mountain View library or any other Timberland Regional Library District (TRL) branch. Due dates will be extended until the library reopens on Tuesday, June 15.
