TRL kiosk offers public library services at Nisqually Tribal Library

In partnership with the Nisqually Tribe, the Timberland Regional Library District (TRL) opened a library service kiosk this summer in the Tribe's library, located on the Nisqually Tribe reservation.

The kiosk is equipped with two computer stations. One provides access to the TRL library catalog, Web site, and reference databases. The other allows Timberland library cardholders to check out their holds that have been delivered to the Nisqually Tribal Library. No Timberland library materials are housed at the Nisqually location other than holds that have arrived for pickup. Any TRL library card holder can use the kiosk to:

- Search the online library catalog and place holds on books, DVDs, CDs and other materials and request that holds be delivered to the Nisqually Tribal Library for pickup.
- Search the TRL online reference databases, including online magazines, newspapers, encyclopedias and many others.
- Search the TRL Web site for upcoming library programs and activities.
- Contact the Timberland "Ask A Librarian" service by phone, email, and online chat to ask a reference question or to ask for help with their library cards or with checking out materials.
- Pick up and check out their holds that have been delivered to the Nisqually Tribal Center Library.
- Check their library card account.
- Sign-up for a computer session at any TRL library.

TRL cardholders can use the TRL catalog from home, school, office or another Timberland library to place a hold on an item for pickup at the Nisqually Tribal Library.

The Nisqually Tribal Library's collection is available to visitors for in-library use only and the staff is happy to assist all visitors. Their catalog can be viewed at www.nisqually-nsn.gov – click on "Programs" and, under the Social Services heading, choose Library.
