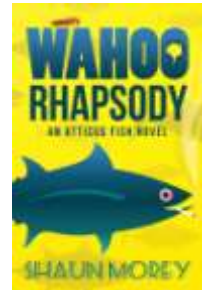

Morey & Dilts: Pair of mystery novelists to talk at Olympia library

Join bestselling writers Shaun Morey (*Wahoo Rhapsody*) and Tyler Dilts (*A King of Infinite Space*) as they read from and discuss their latest novels. As part of a West Coast tour, the authors will be at the [Olympia Timberland Library](#) on Thursday, August 11 from 7:30 to 8:45 p.m. Books will be available for purchase and signing. The event will be held after regular library hours; no other library services will be available.

Both books are mysteries, but there the resemblance ends. *Wahoo Rhapsody* is a madcap romp of mystery and adventure, violence and crime, with a little fishing along the way. The Wahoo Rhapsody is just one of countless charters plying the waters of the Pacific between Cabo San Lucas and San Diego. But it's likely the only boat with a fortune in marijuana, hidden by the first mate inside a fresh catch of yellowfin tuna. Atticus Fish, an expatriate American lawyer, sets out to save the captain and crew from falling prey to drug lord La Cucarach.



Dilts' police procedural, *A King of Infinite Space*, introduces case-hardened homicide detective Danny Beckett of Long Beach, California. Beckett and his partner Jen Tanaka must solve the case of a brutally-murdered English teacher. Beckett delves into the grisly crime with his usual cool persistence, yet as he pieces together the facts, long-suppressed anguish from his own past rises up with stunning force.
