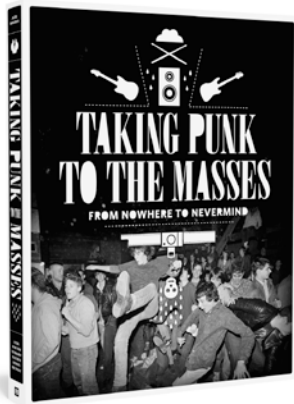

EMP's music archivist presents visual and oral history of Grunge



Jacob McMurray, the Experience Music Project & Science Fiction Museum archivist and author of [Taking Punk to the Masses: from Nowhere to Nevermind](#), will present a visual and oral history of Grunge, the “Seattle Sound,” with an emphasis on the role of Olympia’s music scene during that era. McMurray will be at the Olympia Timberland Library on Friday, August 5 from 7:30 to 9 p.m. Copies of the book will be available for purchase. This event will be held after hours; no other library services will be available.

Taking Punk to the Masses visually documents the explosion of grunge within the context of the underground punk subculture that was developing throughout the US in the late 1970s and 1980s as seen and heard through EMP's oral history and permanent object collection and its cultural archive of over 800 interviews.
