Visit with author Sheila Roberts

Meet Sheila Roberts, author of [*Small Change*](#) and other popular novels that center on women dealing with real-life issues. Roberts will speak at the [Olympia Timberland Library](#) on Wednesday, August 10 from 7:30 to 8:45 p.m. The event will be held after hours; no other library services will be available. Books will be available for purchase.

The characters that populate *Small Change* are like people we know and can relate to: Rachel, newly divorced and cash-strapped, Tiffany, deep in credit card debt, and Jessica, a stay-at-home mom whose husband just lost his job. Ms. Roberts will talk about ways to become fiscally fit—like these friends who band together as the Small Change Club—how to find and protect your financial Achilles Heel, and how to “live large” no matter the size of your income.

Roberts lives in the Pacific Northwest and divides her professional life between speaking engagements and writing. She has seen her books translated into many languages, selected by all the major book clubs, and included in Readers Digest Condensed Books.
