## Investigator to speak on UFOs in the Pacific Northwest

Learn about developments in the field of UFO investigation occurring across the country and right here in Olympia. James Clarkson, a career investigator and ufologist will be at the [Olympia Timberland Library](#) from 7:30 to 8:30 p.m. on Wednesday, November 30 to discuss cases of unidentified flying objects—UFOs—in the Northwest and ideas on the nature of non-human intelligence. The program will be held after hours; no other library services will be available.

The Director of Investigations for the Extraordinary Phenomena Investigations Council (EPIC), Mr. Clarkson has made a study of UFOs for many years. His talk at the library will explore discoveries in science and astronomy that show how contact with extraterrestrial life forms is not just possible, but likely to be in our future. Clarkson is retired from the Aberdeen, Washington police department after 20 years in law enforcement. He trained with the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission in the areas of criminal investigation and police operations.
