



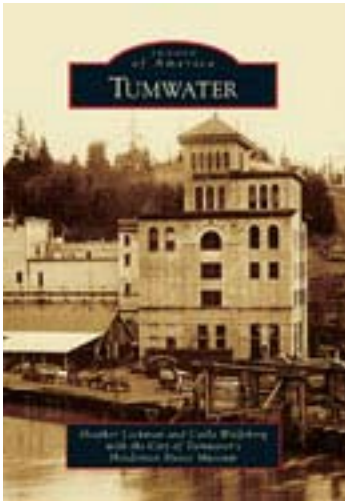

## Local authors discuss new “Images of America” book on Tumwater history



Heather Lockman and Carla Wulfsberg will discuss their new book, *Tumwater*, at the Tumwater Timberland Library on Saturday, November 13 from 2 to 4 p.m. Part of Arcadia Publishing’s Images of America series, *Tumwater* showcases the early settlers that gave birth to the town and the community that flourished from the waters of the Deschutes River. The majority of the images in the profusely illustrated volume were drawn from a collection of more than 1,500 historic photographs in the City of Tumwater’s Henderson House Museum.

Wulfsberg manages the City of Tumwater's historical program at the Henderson House Museum. Heather Lockman writes about history and historic preservation. Their book will be available for purchase at the program.
