

# Using eBooks from Overdrive and your Timberland Regional Library with a mobile device (smartphone or tablet ) such as iPhone, iPad, Android phone, Android tablet, Blackberry, or Windows 7 phone

## Overview

You can check out and download the following types of digital materials through the Overdrive

Download Collection in these formats:

- Adobe® EPUB eBooks
- MP3 audiobooks

To access these digital materials you need...

1. A valid Timberland Regional Library card
2. Internet access
3. A mobile device with the ability to add Apps to it\*
4. To install the free Overdrive Media Console App found on your device's app store website
5. A free Adobe ID (the email address you've registered on Adobe's website)



## Step 1 - Download and install the Overdrive Media Console app made for your device.

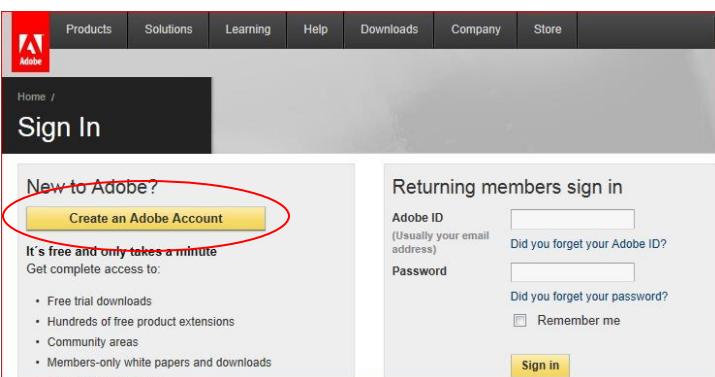
Either go to

- <http://www.overdrive.com/software/omc/> and choose the button for your type of device.

OR

- go to the online app store you use for your device and search for Overdrive Media Console.

(If there is no Overdrive Media Console for your type of device, you must use Adobe Digital Editions installed on a PC/Mac and a USB cable connecting the PC/Mac and your device to get Overdrive ebooks.)



## Step 2 - You need to have an Adobe ID

Activating using an Adobe ID allows you to download and read DRM-protected eBooks on supported eBook mobile devices. To create or renew your Adobe ID:

- Go to <http://www.adobe.com> and choose Sign In.
- In the appropriate fields, enter the email address and password for your Adobe ID. If you do not already have an Adobe ID, click 'Create an Adobe Account' and follow the instructions to sign up for an Adobe ID.
- Remember your Adobe ID and password for use in the next step.

Note: We recommend using the same email address for your Adobe ID that you used to register the device with the company that made it. If you have a brand new device, register it with the manufacturer first, then do Step 2.

### Step 3– Register your device with the Adobe ID

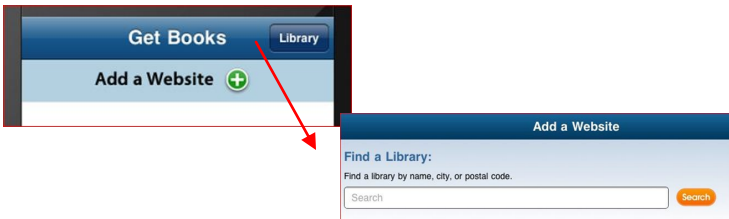
- You must register your device with an Adobe ID within the Settings of the Overdrive Media Console app.
- Find the Settings area for Overdrive Media Console on your device. For example, on an Android device, go to *App Settings > eBook Options*.
- Enter the Adobe ID and password into your device.
- Choose “Authorize”.



### Step 4– Access the Timberland Regional Library's Overdrive eBook Collection

You will need to “add” the Library by:

- Selecting **Get Books +**
- Click **Add a Website**.
- Search for “Timberland” using **Find a Library**.
- Select any Timberland Regional Library branch.

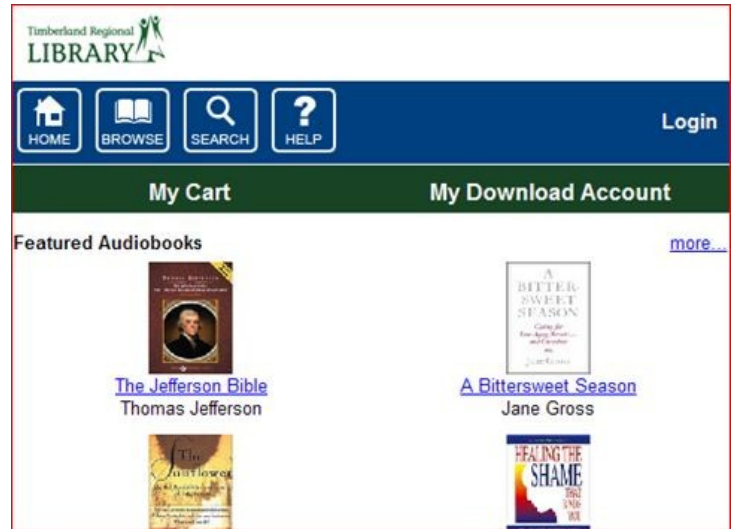
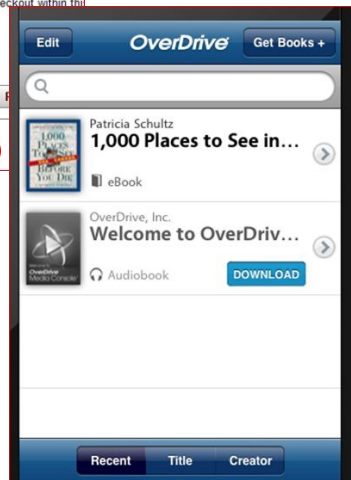
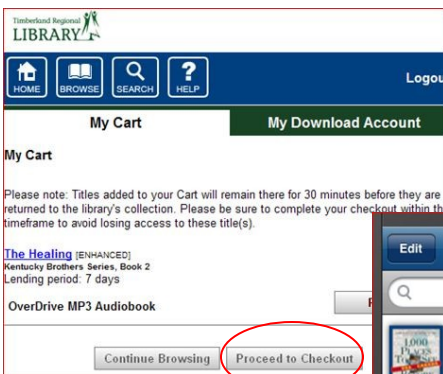


### Step 5 - Search for books using OverDrive's mobile catalog

You can search or browse for eBooks and audiobooks.

- Use Login to enter your library card number and PIN (last 4 digits of your phone number)
- When you locate a title, add it to the cart \*\* and proceed to checkout.
- Review and confirm the title(s) you wish to checkout. (You can also use a PC or Mac to browse and checkout, then come back to your device to download.)

\*\* or Place a Hold to be added to the waitlist.



### Step 6- Checkout, download, and enjoy!

- Once you have checked out a title, click the 'Download' button to start the download. eBooks will download directly into OverDrive Media Console on your device.
- Once the download is complete, open and enjoy the title.
- Click **Bookshelf** to open the books you already have checked out, click on **Get Books** to find more.

You will never accrue late fees with titles you download from Overdrive. At the end of the loan period, titles will expire and be automatically 'returned' to the library. After your loan period has ended, you can delete the expired file(s) from your device.
