



FAQs for Students

1. What is MyTRL?

- A. A MyTRL account gives you (and other students) access to Timberland Regional Library electronic resources.

2. Which electronic resources can I access with MyTRL?

- A. Encyclopedias, magazines, newspapers, eBooks, audiobooks, math and science information, language learning programs, online classes, standardized test preparation materials, music, and videos.

3. How do I get access to MyTRL?

- A. Each K-12 student in the Olympia School District will receive access unless their parent or legal guardian opts them out.

4. How do I log in to MyTRL?

- A. Your account information will be provided to you by your school. Your PIN number is the month and day of your birthday (Example: 0807 for an August 7th birthday). You may change your PIN at any time.

5. Can I check out books with MyTRL?

- A. MyTRL allows for students to view and check out electronic library resources that are automatically returned, so no fines will incur. Students can also upgrade the online-only library card to a regular library card with the parent's permission. Bring your parent to any Timberland library, or have them sign a completed library card application to get an upgraded card for free.

6. What if I already have a library card?

- A. Great! You can keep using that card and your MyTRL card, or you can have the cards merged by going into any Timberland Regional Library branch.
