



Library Takeout CLOSED September 11 & 12, 2020

Because of smoke and unsafe breathing conditions caused by wildfires burning across California, Oregon, and Washington State, Library Takeout service was closed for at least 20 Timberland Regional Library locations on Friday, September 11. Most of the libraries also will not be offering service on Saturday, September 12.

Executive Director Cheryl Heywood and Timberland administrative staff made the decision to close the libraries and stop services to preserve the health and safety of staff and patrons.

"We miss providing Library Takeout to our patrons, and we hope to be back up and open as soon as possible," Heywood said.

Timberland Regional Library locations that have closed or stopped Library Takeout service are as follows:

Grays Harbor County:

Aberdeen, Hoquiam, Elma, Oakville and Westport libraries have closed.

Lewis County:

Centralia, Chehalis, Packwood, Salkum and Winlock libraries have closed.

Mason County:

North Mason in Belfair and **Shelton** libraries have closed.

Pacific County:

Ilwaco, Naselle and **South Bend** libraries have closed. **Raymond** has stopped mobile Library Takeout.

Thurston County:

Lacey, Olympia, Tumwater and **Yelm** libraries have closed. **Tenino**, which was scheduled to reopen on Saturday, Sept. 12, after an extended closure, will remain closed.
