1. Purpose: To provide direction on handling of donations of books and other materials.
2. Scope: Applies to all service points of Timberland Regional Library(TRL).
3. Background: None.
4. Definitions: None.
5. Policy:
 - a. TRL welcomes donations of books and other materials; however, TRL reserves the right to not accept items offered and to decide the disposition of all items that are accepted.
 - b. Materials must comply with the TRL Collection Guidelines Manual in order to be considered for addition to the TRL collection.
 - c. Donations accepted for addition to the TRL collection become the property of TRL and will be placed where most appropriate.
 - d. Donations are subject to the same criteria applied to other materials regarding how they are added to or withdrawn from the collection. Donations that become part of the TRL collection will be available to all residents of the TRL district.
 - e. Materials not utilized in the TRL collection may be sold to the Friends of the local Timberland library for the Friends book sales. The local Friends groups are non-profit

organizations. The proceeds from the Friends book sales are donated to the local library in support of TRL's mission and programs.
