Erin became Library Manager in Shelton in February 2021 and was previously a member of the Aberdeen branch staff for two and a half years.

Erin received her Master of Library and Information Science degree from Simmons College in 2009 and went on to spend nine years in the U.S. Navy. After leaving the Navy, Erin became the circulation supervisor for the Aberdeen, Amanda

Park, and Westport branches of Timberland Regional Library. She later became operations supervisor at the Aberdeen branch, before taking up her new position as the Shelton library manager. Erin also has a Bachelor of Arts in History from Eastern Washington University.

#### We asked Erin some questions about herself and this is what she had to say:
